

Dear people of St Patrick's,

I am sure that our prayers are with all those in Melbourne and more broadly across the nation and indeed the world as we continue to live with the uncertainty around the pandemic and the risks associated with transmission of the virus.

The daily press conference by the Premier and the release of the 24 hour statistics has almost become compulsory viewing.



To those who assist at the liturgies, our marshals, the acolytes, senior servers, altar servers, readers and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion; and in particular the choir, cantors and organists our grateful thanks for ensuring that our liturgical celebrations as much as possible "look normal." Whilst we have been restricted back to 100 persons attending Mass at present, we long for the day when all restrictions will be lifted and we can return to our usual parish life.

During these past months I have wondered how clergy and congregations in the past have managed during the time of a pandemic. During the Spanish Influenza pandemic in 1920 Masses were in fact held outdoors from some of the photos that survive from the time. The previous pandemics were related to Cholera in the mid 19th century, and then of course the bubonic plague (Black Death) that ravaged Europe in the Middle Ages, and then a second wave in Asia in the 19th century. What is clear is that even in the most adverse of circumstances people kept the faith alive even though their participation in the normal activities of a parish were obviously impeded.

The fact is historically there have been pandemics throughout the history of the world. It is that since the Spanish Influenza pandemic we have not been subject to a serious public health crisis. Whilst in recent years we saw the emergence of SAARS in 2002 and MERS in 2012 they were contained relatively quickly. Perhaps this pandemic is a reminder to us all that we are not invincible creatures and are subject to forces beyond our control.

Our Catholic faith then sustains us in both good times and bad, and our reliance on the sacraments of the Church become even more acute during such times. Whilst we cannot gather in the way we normally do and whilst many parish activities are either restricted or suspended, we are still all linked through out common baptism and our membership of the Body of Christ. We need to remember that even in isolation in our homes we are not alone.

Let us pray that those who are caring for COVID patients and those searching for a vaccine would be sustained in their endeavours and that we in the midst of "this valley of tears" may continue to support them through our prayers and adhering to the public health directives.

Message from Bishops Commission for Social Justice, Mission and Service - Social Justice Statement 2020




