

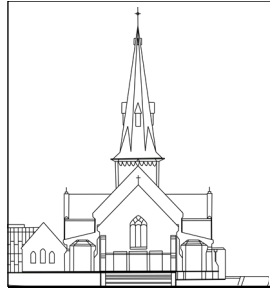

Dear People of St Patrick's,

As we come to the end of the liturgical year with this celebration I want to express once again my appreciation to all of you for what has been a very difficult and challenging year. The pandemic significantly disrupted the worshipping and community life of the Parish, and then the departure of the previous Dean caused many people dismay and raised many questions.

Since I returned to the parish in the middle of the year I have endeavoured to address those matters with both the Parish Pastoral Council, the Parish Finance Committee and that process reached its culmination in the Extraordinary Meeting of Parishioners which was convened last Sunday after the Solemn Mass. Once again, I thank those who attended, and those who submitted questions. Once again I reaffirm what I categorically stated at that meeting that neither the previous Dean, nor the then Financial Administrator have been cited in any correspondence or reports as having engaged in any malfeasance in respect to the financial operations of the parish. That such rumours and innuendo were circulating (mainly through unauthorised social media platforms) is a matter of deep regret and has caused much hurt to many people. As next week we begin a new Liturgical Year let us all look forward with hope to 2021 and a resumption and strengthening of our life as a Parish community focused on the mission of the Gospel. To that end I received an email from Fr Robert Riedling who as you know will become the new Dean and Administrator of the Cathedral Parish when he returns from the UK. Because of the pandemic and the unavailability of flights to Australia Fr Robert does not expect to return to Australia now until early in the New Year. He is looking forward to his new role and sends his greetings from Durham in the north of England where winter is already a present reality for him.

On a more practical note I need to address the question of giving. Traditionally most Catholic parishes have had two collections during Mass on a Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation. The first collection is labelled 'pastoral revenue' and the money collected is used to support the priests of the parish and their upkeep. The second collection is referred to as 'the church account.' The money collected here (either through planned giving and envelopes or direct debit and some loose collection) is used to support the operational expenses of the parish. During the time of the pandemic many people have continued to support the parish and the clergy whilst often facing uncertainty about their own personal finances. We are very grateful for such generosity in uncertain times. At the recent Annual General Meeting of the Board of Management (ie: the clergy members of the fund who are supported by the first collection) a motion was moved to investigate having only one collection at Mass which would incorporate the first and second collections. This would mean that a percentage of monies collected would be apportioned to the support of the clergy and the balance would be used for the operations of the parish. After discussions with other clergy and also the Parish Manager I have decided given the current situation with the pandemic that beginning the 1st Sunday of Advent we will only have one collection at Mass during the time of the Offertory. Therefore, I am asking parishioners that you consider your giving on the basis that in future there will be only one collection. If you are using envelopes you might want to increase the amount to reflect what you would normally place in the first collection. If you currently have a direct debit facility with your bank you might consider altering the amount to include what you would normally give in the first collection. There are many people who now prefer the option of "cashless" transactions; parishioners and visitors will be aware that we now have a number of *tap 'n' go* points in the Cathedral with various amounts designated at each point, and placing a cash offering on a plate or in a
