Dear People of St Patrick's,

As we begin the Second Week of Advent our Gospel presents us with a character all too familiar to us, John the Baptist. Growing up I frequently questioned the importance of this man. When one reads parts of the Old Testament one hears of the many great holy men and women in history. They are exalted for their



courage, their zeal, but most importantly their faith. I was always impressed with Moses who, despite the constant infidelities of the Israelites, continues to exhibit faithfulness to God in his unyielding efforts to bring God's chosen people to the promised land. Yet he is not in the same 'level' per se with John the Baptist.

We hear in Matthew's Gospel, Jesus proclaim, 'Truly, I say to you, among those born of women there has risen no one greater than John the Baptist.' What is it that makes this man so great? John's greatness is defined in his littleness. How so? John, being born of Zechariah and Elizabeth, is from the priestly caste. He could have asserted himself as another religious leader if he wanted to. However, in John the Baptist we see one who embodies his vocation, the voice crying out in the wilderness, through his littleness. John states 'Someone is following me, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to kneel down and undo the strap of his sandals.' What does this imply? John's humility aids his mission as he directs those who come his way towards Christ. As such, he is the model for all vocations.

Vocation is God's call to holiness in a specific way of life. However, all vocations share in the same mission; bringing others to know, love and serve the Lord. As we approach Christmas may we follow the great example of John the Baptist. May we follow the path of humility so that our mission may truly flourish.


