My dear friends,

Last weekend the parish staff and some representatives went off for a day of reflection to the Shrine of the Holy Innocents in Kellyville. The day was aimed at taking time away from the usual workings of the Parish to focus on



ourselves, our relationship with God, and how we may be of greater service to the Cathedral Parish. Two religious assisted with the spirituality part of the day: Fr Anthony Scerri and Sr Elizabeth Brennan. Whilst there were many great aspects discussed, one topic that really struck a chord with me was the idea of love expressed by the great Carmelite Saints: St. Therese of Avila, St. John of the Cross and St. Therese of Lisieux. To help navigate this behemoth of a subject we were blessed with the presence of Fr. Anthony, a Carmelite from Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Wentworthville. Fr. Anthony informed us that his commitment to the Carmelites spans a mere 71 years which, in his words, gives him "a bit of knowledge into the spirituality of these Masters of Prayer." Of course we couldn't cover every aspect of their works but Fr. Anthony captured their writings in one word: 'love'. "To love", he said, "is a dangerous thing. It is dangerous as it demands so much from oneself as it must look outward. To say 'I love you' must never be superficial. It demands that we give of ourselves to the other for their highest good."

My dear friends, our Gospel for this weekend, the Fourth Sunday of Lent (*Laetare Sunday*), speaks of the incredible love the great saints lived out. I'm not referring to a sentimental love we see in the movies but something much greater; God's love for us. 'God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life.' (Jn 3:16) Jesus' words highlights the extent of the Father's love for us; He gives that which is most precious to Him in order to bring us, His people, to the perfect love of the Trinity. He gave up his life so that we may have eternal life.

As we approach Holy Week may we be inspired by the Holy Spirit to love like the Father. May we, in the words of St. Thomas Aquinas, 'will the good of the other' and so directs our hearts towards Heaven.
