“How to be like Mary...”



Did you know that Mother's Day used to be called “Mothering Sunday”? Mothering Sunday was a day honouring mothers, and mother churches have been celebrating in the United Kingdom, Ireland, and elsewhere in the English-speaking world, on the Fourth Sunday in Lent since the Middle Ages. On Mothering Sunday, Christians have historically visited their mother church - the church of their baptism. Constance Adelaide Smith revived its modern observance in 1913 to honour Mother Church, 'mothers of earthly homes', Mary, mother of Jesus, and Mother Nature.

Motherhood is dear to us because we all have a mother. Even Jesus had a mother – a young Jewish woman called Miriam (Mary). She was ordinary but special because God chose her to be the mother of God's Son, Jesus. With all the titles we have given her, we may forget that she was one of us, a mother like many other mothers, worrying about her Son and how she was going to give him an education. She raised her son in the Jewish faith tradition as expressed in the Torah. She kept everything in her heart (Lk 2:19). Mary and Joseph had to migrate to Egypt to protect the life of their Son. She was devastated when she lost Jesus for three days, only to find him in the Temple. Mary was a guest at a wedding in Cana, asking her Son to assist the newlywed couple since they had run out of wine. She was there under the cross during her Son's crucifixion and with the apostles after Jesus rose from the death. As we read in the Gospel today, she has remained in her Son's love and her joy has been complete, not because she did not suffer but because she kept God's commandment to love. God has chosen her and commissioned her to bear fruit that lasts for ever. She was unique in the way she participated in salvation history.

Mary, the Mother of Jesus and Mother of God is the model for all of us, young and old, to emulate. Her relationship with Jesus was no doubt unique but she continues to be our sister within the Communion of Saints. The 'mission' of Christ in this world is not complete as yet and He needs us. I found this anonymous hymn very inspiring. It gives us a practical way to be like Mary, our Mother - an assured pathway to her Son, Jesus.

 Mary the grape, Christ the Sacred Wine!
 Mary the wheat sheaf, Christ the living Bread;
 Mary the rose tree, Christ the Rose blood-red!
 Mary the font, Christ the Cleansing Flood'
 Mary the chalice, Christ the Saving Blood!
 Mary the temple, Christ the temple's Lord;
 Mary the shrine, Christ the God adored!
 Mary the beacon, Christ the Haven's Rest;
 Mary the mirror, Christ the Vision Blest!
 Mary the mother, Christ the mother's Son.
 Both ever blest while endless ages run.
 Amen.

DID YOU KNOW...

.....that on Thursday this week, some parts of the Catholic world will celebrate the Ascension?

In Australia we will celebrate the Feast of the Ascension next Sunday, whereas those parts of the world that celebrate the Ascension on Thursday celebrate next Sunday as the Seventh Sunday of Easter. The day for celebrating the Ascension is determined mostly by various Bishops' conferences, not determined centrally by Rome. There are advantages to both approaches: celebrating the Ascension on Thursday of the sixth week of Easter is forty days after Easter Sunday, so true to the New Testament narrative (Acts 1:3,9), whereas celebrating it on the Sunday allows more people to hear of this remarkable event than would otherwise hear it at a weekday Mass.




