## "There is no sadness in the Ascension ..."



GROWING UP IN A CATHOLIC HOUSEHOLD my siblings and I were taught at a very early age how to recite the rosary. This particular devotion, with its biblical roots, allowed us to learn about the life of Christ through the eyes of our Blessed Mother. Upon reflection I definitely see the benefit of saying the family rosary on a daily basis, though five-year-old Christopher del Rosario couldn't wait till it was over. As an extremely energetic child I struggled to sit still for twenty minutes as the family sat around the statue of Our Lady; one could say "fidget" was my middle name! In order to combat this my good mother taught me to use my imagination when reciting the rosary. She taught me to place myself in the mystery, to be a character in that particular moment in the life of Christ and watch as the scene unfolds. To this day I still use this lesson to guide me in my Marian meditation. This brings me to today.

Dear friends, we celebrate on this day the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Christ's earthly life ends as he is taken up to Heaven in a cloud. When meditating on the occasion, keeping in mind this event is the second glorious mystery, I can't help but feel a great sense of sadness. If Christ really did love us, why did he leave? Why couldn't he have stayed with us for ever? We make so many mistakes, couldn't he have stayed to show us the way? With questions like this one can't help but feel a sense of emptiness following Christ's Ascension. Yet we bear in mind the words of Christ,

*"I am with you always, to the close of the age."* (Mt 28:20)

There is no sadness in the Ascension, no emptiness. To hold such sentiments is to miss the point of Christ's departure. The Ascension gives rise to the purpose and mission of every Christian. We are called to proclaim the risen Christ to the world through the witness of our lives. We hold fast to the very fact that through Him death is conquered, sin destroyed and eternal life is found in Him. Our lives therefore must be an upward movement. We live, work and breathe with our feet firmly planted in the world but with our hearts and mind directed towards Heaven. Through the Ascension, our faith, hope and love in Christ is fortified as we are given the assurance that He, Our Lord Jesus Christ, now dwells with the Father in love to prepare a place for us.



## Saint of the Week


### 19<sup>th</sup> May - Blessed Raphael Louis Rafiringa (1856-1919)

Born in Antananarivo, Madagascar, on 01 May 1856. His father was a noble member of an important and powerful tribe and was a functionary at the Queen's court, in charge of the royal slaves. Raphael received his education from the Queen's sorcerers. In 1866, he met some missionaries from the Christian Brothers and saw that they were greater than his teachers. He chose baptism at the age of 14 and took the baptismal name Raphael.

He taught at the De La Salle Brotherhood's school from the age of 17, and later joined the order, becoming the first native of Madagascar to do so.

When the Christian missionaries were expelled from the island in 1883, Brother Raphael was put in charge of the nascent Christian community. When the missionaries were allowed to return a few years later, they found a strong and numerous Christian community.

Raphael took his final vows in 1889 and devoted himself to intense literary work, defending the rights of the Catholic Church in Madagascar, as well as writing textbooks for schools and various religious works. He died on 19 May 1919 and was beatified by pope Benedict XVI in 2009.

## NEWS FROM ROME



Pope Francis issued a letter this week on 10 May (called a 'motu proprio') with the title **Antiquum Ministerium** ('Ancient Ministry'). By this, Francis has formally established the lay ministry of Catechist, a ministry which has been important in the Church since its infancy. CathNews states that "...while millions of lay men and women around the world already serve as catechists, readers and altar servers, formal institution into the ministries signifies that the service is stable, delegated by the bishop and publicly recognised by the church."

## Feast of the Ascension


May 13th or Sunday May 16th, 2021

But we know that we will see our friends again, and we will be with the people who died when we die and go to Heaven.




Today let us celebrate Jesus returning to the Father in Heaven, and remember that we hope to join them some day!
