About the "O Antiphons"

SINCE 17 DECEMBER, the Church has turned her gaze away from the figure of John the Baptist who heralded the coming of the Christ toward the events leading up to the Nativity itself. Liturgically, this has been marked by prayers more earnestly imploring the Lord to come, with his advent drawing nearer. Of particular significance has been the use of the 'O Antiphons' which occur at the Gospel Acclamation during mass and accompany the



Magnificat during Vespers. Interestingly enough, these are also the basis for the verses in the famous Advent hymn, "O come, O come, Emmanuel," which fills our churches at this time of year.

Not much is known about the origins of the use of these verses in liturgical celebrations, but they are nevertheless ancient, their use becoming mainstream by the eighth century. Each antiphon highlights at once a particular title of the Messiah (O Wisdom, O Lord (Leader), O Root of Jesse, O Key of David, O Rising Sun, O King of the Nations, O Emmanuel), as well as a prophecy from Isaiah about the Messiah's coming. If the first letter of each of the Latin words for these titles is taken, starting from the last antiphon to the first, the Latin phrase *ERO CRAS* is spelt (**E**[mmanuel] **R**[ex Gentium] **O**[riens] **C**[lavis David] **R**[adix Jesse] **A**[donai] **S**[apientia]), which translates as, "tomorrow, I will come." In this creative way, the Church intensifies her Advent preparation of the coming of the saviour into the world at Christmas, and brings this season to a joyful crescendo.

Meditation upon each antiphon promises to be a most fruitful exercise, a way of spiritually preparing for the birth of Jesus. Having done so, we will see that when we approach the Nativity scene to worship the baby who lays in the manger, we kneel before the Wisdom and the Word of God, who guides all things in power and love; the Leader of the House of Israel who gave the Law to Moses on Sinai; the Root of Jesse prophesied by Isaiah, a sign of God's love for his people; the Key of David who opens the gates of God's Kingdom; the Radiant Dawn, the sun of justice, the splendour of eternal light; the King of all nations; Emmanuel, God-is-with-us. It is no mere babe who lays within.

I pray that our final preparations for Christmas will make our hearts truly ready to receive such a one as this.

This Sunday is the last morning tea for 2024.


The Hospitality Group will take a break, ready to return reinvigorated for the Café's reopening on the first Sunday in February 2025.
