A Message from Bishop Vincent

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The tragedy at Bondi Beach [last Sunday] has shocked and deeply saddened our entire community, with many carrying fear, grief and unanswered questions.

Such violence is a grave assault on human dignity and can never be justified. We condemn this act unequivocally and reject all hatred that seeks to harm innocent people. There is no place for antisemitism, especially in Australia.

Together with all people, and with the wisdom of the Holy Spirit, we stand in solidarity with the Jewish community and pray for all those affected - those who have lost their lives or been injured, and the many individuals, families and communities whose lives have been changed in an instant.

We also pray for the first responders, healthcare workers, and members of the public who acted with courage and compassion in the face of danger - protecting others, offering help and bringing calm and support amid uncertainty. These acts of self-giving love and care reflect the very best of our humanity, our shared values, and our hope for each other.

Let us continue to offer our care, compassion and prayers, calling on Mary, our Mother and Queen of Peace, to intercede for us.

At times like this, it is vital that we do not allow fear or anger to divide us. Violence, retaliation and discrimination are never the answer, even in the face of terrorism and antisemitism.

As Pope Leo XIV reminds us, peace is "an unarmed peace and a disarming peace, humble and persevering. It comes from God, God who loves us all unconditionally." This is the peace to which we are called, even when the path is difficult.

I invite our Diocesan community to pray for healing, for comfort for all who mourn, and for a renewed commitment to unity, mutual respect and peace across our diverse faiths and cultures. May we continue to stand together against violence in all its forms. May God be close to all who are suffering, and may His peace rest upon our community.

Support for our Jewish friends

You will notice that this weekend I have chosen to reproduce the message released by Bishop Vincent in response to the shocking events that took place last Sunday at Bondi Beach, an event that made news around the world.

Feeling that a more local response was also demanded, the Parish Pastoral Council felt that a letter to the local Jewish community would be a good way to show our support for this community at this terrible time. The text ran as follows:

Dear Rabbi Cohavi,

I am writing to you in response to the shocking events that took place at Bondi Beach on Sunday, 04 December. During a peaceful and joyful celebration of the first night of Hanukkah, members of the Jewish community were subjected to violence that has deeply shaken us all. As people of faith, we grieve alongside those who mourn, and we lament yet another tragic moment that has become all too familiar in our world today.

These senseless killings have shocked and sickened all Australians who value the sanctity of all human life.

I write on behalf of the parishioners of St Patrick's Cathedral, Parramatta, who, at this time, wish to reach out to our Jewish brothers and sisters who are mourning the loss of so many people who share their faith. We stand by you in solidarity and want to assure you of our prayerful support at this time. We can only imagine the grief and anger that Jewish people must be feeling at this time, especially in light of the history of persecution and prejudice that has marked the life of people of Jewish faith for so many centuries.

Once again, we stand by you in solidarity and will hold all those affected by this senseless tragedy in prayer before the one God we all love as brothers and sisters with Abraham as our common father.

26 December - St Stephen, Martyr


