“Repent, for the kingdom of God is close at hand.”

Advent is from the Latin word “advenire” or “adventus,” which means to come or coming. Advent thus refers to the coming of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. This coming could be seen in three different phases.

The first coming refers to the mystery of the incarnation, when the Word took flesh in the womb of the Virgin Mary. In this coming, Jesus came to redeem the fallen human race. There's a second coming, which is called the “parousia”. It refers to the return of Jesus Christ during which he would gather his elect, those who are waiting for his appearance. In between these two comings, however, there's an intermittent coming of Jesus in the daily lives and events of people. What is expected in this coming is awareness and attention to the presence of Jesus among us for He is Emmanuel, God with us.

On this Second Sunday of Advent, we're challenged to prepare for the coming of Jesus Christ. How are we to prepare? It is good to tidy up our living spaces and houses of worship, to decorate and beautify everywhere in the spirit of festivities. All these must be done without neglecting the most essential, namely the tidying up of our hearts to welcome Jesus Christ. This is because Jesus is the reason for the season.

The prophet Isaiah tells us in the First Reading that God does not judge by appearances and gives no verdict by hearsay. This means that what matters most is a life of holiness and integrity. It is not sufficient to cleanse everywhere except our hearts. This would be tantamount to a whitewashed tomb that's full of bones and dirt.

Paul asserts in the Second Reading that it is to God's glory for us to treat each other in a friendly manner as Jesus has treated us. We must therefore be there for one another, bearing one another's burdens with love. It is in the nature of human beings to be selfish and self-centred. It is only by the grace of regeneration obtained through the blood of Jesus Christ that we're able to transform into selfless persons looking out always for the good of others (Phil 2:2-11).

This conversion is the message of the gospel passage today. John invites everyone to embrace the path of “metanoia”, that is, repentance, in order to be ready for the kingdom so described in the First Reading. Nobody is excluded from this clarion call, which requires an inward transformation (Rom 12:1-2). We should not be complacent and lethargic about the need for conversion. This is because none of us is perfect. Therefore, there's always the need to continue improving on the quality of our Christian life.

The Advent Season this year is a great opportunity for us to make amends where necessary so that Jesus would find a fitting dwelling place at Christmas. We should also seize this opportunity to reach out to the less privileged among us so as to enable them to have a glimpse of the good news occasioned by the birth of Jesus. Let our love not be only on the lips, but let it go out in good works to others (James 2:14ff).






Mass times over Christmas & New Year



Saint of the Week

09 December - St Juan Diego Cuauhtlatotzin (1474 - 1548), Hermit

He was born in about 1474 in Cuauhtitlan in the kingdom of Texcoco, part of present-day Mexico. As an adult he embraced Christianity and he and his wife were baptized. In 1531 the Mother of God appeared to him, on the hill called Tepeyac near Mexico City, and told him to ask the bishop to have a church built on the spot. Through the purity of his faith, his humility and his fervour, a church was built, in honour of Our Lady of Guadalupe (whose feast is celebrated on 12 December). He left everything and devoted himself to the care of the sanctuary and the reception of pilgrims until his death in 1548.


