## "But I say this to you..."

TIME IS SO precious for most people these days that we often assess the minimum we need to do to satisfy the completion of a task. It might be something like a superior asking us to write something and so we recycle, with a few amendments, an old piece of work. We might be asked to count a great quantity of something and instead make an informed estimate. Shortcuts, so long as they still adequately satisfy set criteria, are a common way of making busy lives a little easier.

We can have the same attitude towards our faith life, too. "Meeting the minimum requirements" is not something unknown to us Catholics. In some ways, our faith encourages this, asking us to attend Mass on Sundays and on days of Holy Obligation, to receive communion once a year and confess once a year if we are bearing mortal sin. Combine this with fasting and abstinence from time to time, and most people don't find it too difficult to "live as a Catholic" even if there might be the odd "breach of contract" on occasion, something that can be dealt with through the sacrament of Reconciliation. But we have "ticked the boxes", nonetheless.

Jesus sees it differently. Jesus always calls us to a deeper and more meaningful manner of living out the Gospel, not to make us work harder or because he is on a power trip, but because he knows it is a more satisfying and genuine way of living. Jesus makes this most clear in the Sermon on the Mount.

On a sidenote, it is a little unfortunate that we won't be celebrating this year the Masses of the 7th, 8th and 9th Sundays in Ordinary Time because we would then be hearing more of the Sermon on the Mount. We can, of course, read it for ourselves, and I would encourage you to do so. I sometimes feel that if I were asked to choose just one section of the Gospels to preserve for posterity, it would be chapters 5 – 7 of Matthew, the full version of the Sermon on the Mount, often referred to as a blueprint for Christian discipleship.

So, rather than seeking a minimalist approach to our faith, let us look at our faith as Jesus wants us to. Jesus uses the phrase "But I say this to you" as a means of showing how he fulfils the Law. Yes, it is wrong to commit adultery, but let us seek to be people who have such an intimate connection with God that even the thought of adultery never crosses our mind. Yes, it is wrong to kill, but again, a strong faith will help ensure that hatred, which might lead to killing, is never on the agenda. And so on, and so on.

Jesus tells his disciples, and us too, that our virtue needs to go deeper than that of someone who merely follows the law for its sake. We need to do the right thing because it is the right thing to do, not feel good that we have "satisfied minimum requirements" so as to call ourselves Christian disciples.

And when we do this, difficult as it may be at times, we will find an inner peace and fulfilment that will, in and of itself, help spread the love of Christ.

## Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) update

At our February meeting we passed a vote of thanks to Helena Roumanus who has stepped down from the PPC due to her other commitments. We appreciate Helena's contribution over the past 18 months.

We received with gratitude the news that Rabbi Kohavi from Parramatta Synagogue replied to Fr Robert's letter of solidarity with the Jewish community following the Bondi shootings, and Fr Robert accepted the Rabbi's invitation to attend the local Hanukkah celebration with other local religious leaders.

We discussed plans for parish engagement on the proposal to offer overnight shelter in the Cloister Hall for local homeless people. This proposal was announced to the parish at large last weekend and there will be further opportunities to explain what it involves. We are keen to hear your questions and comments.

The Open Arms group led by Dianne Starkey updated the PPC with a report on all that has happened since the refugee family we are sponsoring arrived in November and the many steps taken to help them settle into life in Australia.

The PPC itself is seeking to work in a more synodal manner with the PFC (Parish Finance Committee) so that the financial implications of proposed activities are better considered going forward, while appreciating the already substantial parishioner generosity towards the parish and to other wonderful causes.

Apart from attending Mass, if you are not currently part of other parish activities, could you be? We are wondering about ways to assist more regular Mass attenders to become involved in one of our parish ministries and this will be a continuing focus.

## Saint of the Week


21 February - St Peter Damian (1007 - 1072), Bishop, Doctor

Peter Damian was born in Ravenna in 1007 and studied theology and canon law, becoming a renowned teacher in both Parma and Ravenna. In his late twenties he abandoned all this and joined the hermitage of Fonte Avellana, near Gubbio, where he became prior in 1043: a position he held until his death. He strongly promoted the religious life in many parts of Italy. The Church at that time was in a terrible state and he supported the Popes in their efforts at reform, both by his writings and as a papal envoy. Pope Stephen IX named him a cardinal and Bishop of Ostia. He died on 21 February 1072 and was immediately acclaimed as a saint.
