## A Good Shepherd

SO MANY VOICES...

It is commonly quoted that the average person is now exposed to more information in one day than a person in the fifteenth century was exposed to in their entire life! With social media, 24/7 news cycles, digital content, texts, alerts, notifications – we have a never-ending stream of information coming at us. The pure scale of it can be overwhelming, and then there is the fact that much of what we hear is contradictory – how can we decide which things to believe? When we stopped buying newspapers, media outlets had to change their business models. Now, unless you pay for a subscription news service, most of our news is being paid for in some other way – “click bait” advertising, selling our information, or political influence.



In the midst of all this, unsurprisingly, people have gravitated towards “influencers” to help them navigate through this sea of information and disinformation. But we need to ask ourselves: “What is their business model? Why do they say what they say? Are they receiving advertising revenue? Are they exercising political influence?” Almost all of them have some angle, and we need to be very aware of that. They may say that they really want to help people, and for some of them that may be true, but if they are being paid one way or another, they are really helping themselves and not the people they are influencing. And “the proof of the pudding is in the eating”.... the massive rise in social media and constant information has gone hand in hand with a massive rise in depression, anxiety, loneliness, and unhappiness.

In the last couple of years, we have seen a dramatic rise in the number of people choosing to become Catholics. It has been wonderful, but in many ways, this is a response to the lack of substance that the “world” offers. Substance, meaning, significance, truth, real comfort, real guidance, all these reside where they have always resided, in Jesus Christ, and in the Church that He established to spread, and share, and live out, His Good News. In a world of constant change, Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

In today's gospel Jesus tells us that the other voices in our lives have come to steal from us, so nothing really has changed on that. Jesus, however, has come “that they may have life, and have it to the full.” I love this promise. I have built my life around this promise, and this promise has given me a “life to the full”. There is plenty of challenge in my life, and a fair share of suffering, but I would not swap my life for any other life. Not for any amount of wealth, power or anything else.

This is Good Shepherd Sunday, traditionally a Sunday for people to think about if they are called to a vocation. Some people are called to the vocation of religious life – to be a Priest, a Sister, a Brother, or a Deacon. Others are called to a ministry of one sort or another. Every single person is called. So, perhaps it is time that you decided whose voice you are going to listen to – the voices that one way or another are stealing from you, or the voice that longs to offer you “life to the full”.

## St Patrick's Cemetery - Exciting News!

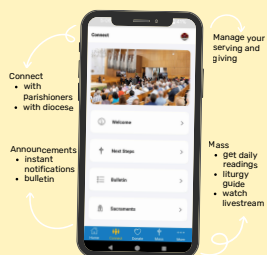
As part of the National Trust Heritage Festival, St Patrick's Cemetery will be holding two open days to include the historic St Francis of Assisi Chapel.

## Saint of the Week

29 April - St Catherine of Siena (1347 - 1380), Virgin, Doctor

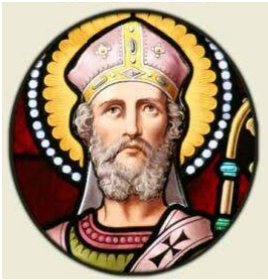
Catherine was born in Siena and, seeking perfection, entered the Third Order of the Dominicans when she was still in her teens. In 1370 she was commanded by a vision to leave her secluded life and enter the public life of the world. She wrote letters to many major public figures and carried on a long correspondence with Pope Gregory XI, urging him to reform the clergy and the administration of the Papal States. She burned with the love of God and her neighbour. As an ambassador she brought peace and harmony between cities. She fought hard to defend the liberty and rights of the Popes and did much for the renewal of religious life. She also dictated books full of sound doctrine and spiritual inspiration. She died on 29 April 1380. In 1970 Pope Paul VI declared her a Doctor of the Church.
