## The Message of Divine Mercy

THIS SECOND SUNDAY of Easter is known by many names: 'Quasi Modo' Sunday, taken from the first words of the ancient Latin Introit; 'Albus' or 'White Sunday', recalling the day on which the neophytes (the newly baptised) would process around the Church in their baptismal albs; 'Doubting Thomas Sunday', reflecting the Gospel passage; and 'Low Sunday' or 'the Octave Day', marking the close of the eight-day Easter Sunday celebrations.



It was not until the Jubilee of the year 2000 that Pope St John Paul II instituted this Sunday as a new feast, now known as 'Divine Mercy Sunday'. On this day, a Plenary Indulgence is also made available to the faithful who participate in the devotions associated with it and fulfil the usual conditions.

There is little doubt that this feast arose from the private revelations received by the Polish nun St Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, through a series of apparitions from our Blessed Lord. It is quite uncommon for the Church to endorse even commendable private revelation in such a manner. The message of Divine Mercy, however, is not something extraneous to the Gospel, but one that penetrates to its very heart. In today's Gospel, the Risen Christ dispenses His peace and humbly entrusts to the Apostles the authority to forgive sins, thereby ensuring that His Divine Mercy remains readily available to the Church's children.

Pope St John Paul II would surely have been sensitive to the timeliness of these early twentieth-century revelations. As a child of that century - one which, despite its self-assurance to sophistication, "enlightenment", and historical superiority, witnessed unprecedented death, horror, and violence as the world divested itself of God - he surely recognised the urgency and necessity of this message. Both these revelations and his own birth occurred between the two world wars.

The message of Divine Mercy, though deeply consoling, is also a difficult pill to swallow. It challenges our self-perception and unsettles our pride, reminding us that the world is wounded and fallen, and that each of us stands in need of the mercy that calls us to repentance. It is we who must answer today's Gospel by liberating ourselves of pride and exposing and uncovering our own hidden wounds to the Divine Healer. Divine Mercy is a particularly poignant message in our own time, as we sense the fragility of the world order around us. Christ shows us that, although His mercy is freely given, it is by no means cheap; the wounds He reveals are its price, a sum we are too poor to pay. Even in the light of Easter Sunday, the Resurrection remains inseparably bound to the scandal of Good Friday. It is "Christ crucified" whom we preach.

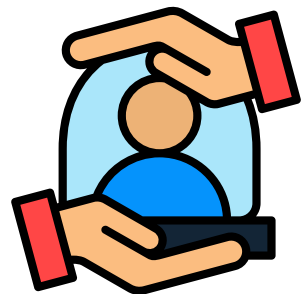

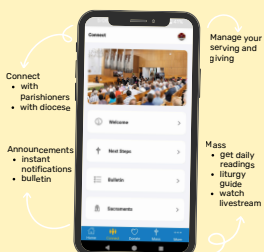
## St Pat's Matters - What has Holy Week meant for you?

## Saint of the Week

17 April - Blessed Clara Gambacorta (1362 - 1419), Religious

Blessed Clara was born in Pisa in 1362, married at the age of twelve and widowed at the age of fifteen. She longed to join a religious order, but her family objected. When at last they relented, upon the advice of Saint Catherine of Siena she received the Dominican habit at the Monastery of the Holy Cross in Pisa. In 1385 along with Blessed Maria Mancini she founded the Monastery of Saint Dominic in Pisa where regular observance was strictly maintained. She was noted for her great prudence and charity, especially in pardoning the assassin of her father and brothers. She prized study and urged her sisters to do likewise. She died on April 17, 1419.

### Did You Know...?

**...that the Second Sunday of Easter used to be commonly referred to as “Low Sunday”?**

Though this may seem a strange name, it refers to the fact that the previous Sunday, Easter Sunday, is the pinnacle of the Church’s year, and so is a “high” Sunday. By referring to the Second Sunday of Easter as “Low Sunday” the contrast between the beginning and end of the Easter Octave (the eight days which begin on Easter Sunday) is highlighted. This Sunday is also referred to as St Thomas Sunday, Divine Mercy Sunday and Quasimodo Sunday.
