God's call is more by grace than by merit

ON THIS FIFTH Sunday of Easter, the Church invites us to reflect on the nature of the Christian calling. In the First Reading, the Apostles chose seven helpers called deacons (diaconoi - δίακονοί) to assist in the work of the distribution of food to the widows and needy in the church. This was done after praying and laying hands on them. We must take note of the criteria set by the apostles which must be met by those to be elected deacons namely: men of good reputation, filled with the Holy Spirit and wisdom. These conditions enabled them to carry out their tasks with conviction and uprightness. Consequently, the word of God continued to spread and more believers were won over to the Lord.



St Peter addressed the church in the Second Reading about the general choice and election of the people by God. God chose those to share in the royal priesthood of his Son not simply by their own merits but as a result of grace made abundant to them. Hence, he says: "You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a consecrated nation, a people set apart to sing the praises of God who called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light." So, being called into this new life is a privilege but it is also something which must elicit a positive response. The early Christians understood this and responded positively to their call and election by God. We are all challenged today to continue to elicit a positive response to our own calling and election by our way of living so that more people may be won over to the Lord as happened in the early church.

The Gospel passage today gives us a glimpse of the early Christians. They were not perfect before they were called. They were rather called in spite of their weaknesses and imperfections as it is often said: God does not call the qualified, rather, he qualifies the called (Jer. 1:4-10). As part of his farewell speech to his apostles and disciples, Jesus was telling them of his impending departure from them and what would happen thereafter. However, many of them, if not all, did not understand what he was saying despite the fact that he had been with them and tutored them for about three years. Two of them were bold enough to question him, Thomas and Philip. When Jesus told the disciples that they knew where he was going, Thomas did not hide his ignorance. He said: Lord, we do not know where you are going....Again, when Jesus told them that they already knew his father, Philip objected and said: Lord, let us see the Father and we shall be satisfied. Jesus rebuked both of them and seized the opportunity to further educate and enlighten them about his person and mission on earth and his relationship with God his Father.

It is a fact that many of us are ignorant about some of the doctrines in the church and in the bible and yet are timid to ask questions from those who have the duty to enlighten us. It is not sufficient to just attend Sunday Mass. We must deepen our knowledge of the bible and church doctrines so as to be better enabled to enlighten others, for no one can give what he does not have "Nemo dat quod non habet". Let us join some faith nurturing groups in the church and make our faith active and productive.

Experience Mary's Presence: Host the Legion of Mary statue

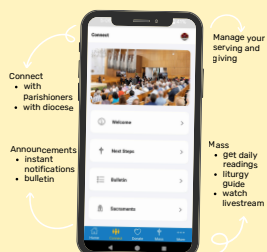
Parishioners are warmly invited to welcome the Legion of Mary statue into their homes for one week.

Saint of the Week

07 May - Blessed Albert of Bergamo (1214 - 1279), Religious

Blessed Albert was born in Valle d'Ogna near Bergamo in 1214. As a married man he was known for his generosity to the poor, a virtue for which his wife reproached him. Upon the death of his wife, being childless, he left his father's farm and went to Cremona where he lived in poverty. His poverty was a witness to a group of heretics there who boasted of their own poverty. Attracted by the life of Saint Dominic he joined the Brothers of Penance, which later became the Order of Penance of Saint Dominic, and lived at the Dominican priory. He died on 07 May 1279.
