"If you love me you will keep my commandments."

AS THE CHURCH prepares for the feast of the Ascension and the coming of the Holy Spirit at the feast of Pentecost, we meditate on our Lord's final words to His apostles before He departs this world on Good Friday. The so-called "farewell discourse" of Holy Thursday's Last Supper is Christ's last-ditch effort to instil His teachings in the Apostles, highlighting for us the foundational principles of the New Covenant which will be consummated before their eyes.



Today we hear from Christ: "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." To some, this pairing of "love" and "commandment" might seem rather odd, especially if one's general impression of Christ is one of a sort-of anarchist or free-loving guy who came to unfetter us from the burden of rules or the intrusion of laws into our freedom. Christ, however, came "...not to abolish the law and the prophets, but to fulfill them" (Mt 5:17). If anything, our Lord strengthens the rule of law, demanding not a mere external adherence to it, but a total transformation of a person, so much so that even anger is murdering another in your heart (Mt 5:21).

In pairing "commandment" and "love," our Lord is giving us the means to understand this New Covenant as a law of love. The extreme of lawlessness will fail to bring order to the Kingdom of God, and a slavish compliance would fail to enact its transforming power. As a law of love, the law draws us into a true relationship, into a true communion. The Apostles will soon witness in Christ that the New Covenant of love will demand a total giving over of self, a love shaped like the cross. It is in the freedom given to us when we can break from the prison of our ego, pride, and selfishness and authentically say, "Not my will, but Thine" (Lk 22:42).

The psalmist tells us that "the law of the LORD is perfect; it revives the soul...; the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple" (Ps 19). Today, Christ tells us that this new life will come by means of the Spirit of Truth, who will draw us into the fullness and newness of life in the profound mystery of the Triune life - where Christ lives in the Father, we in Christ, and Christ in us.

This weekend, in our civil calendar, we celebrate Mother's Day. Our Mother Church is greatly indebted to the lived-out vocation of mothers who witness uniquely to this law of love in their daily selfless sacrifices. Mothers not only bring forth and nurture our physical life, but are instrumental in our spiritual nourishment, often being the ones who introduce us into the life of Christ by teaching us prayer and instructing us in the faith. We turn especially in this month of May to our Immaculate Mother, who embodies and perfectly demonstrates the wonder of allowing the divine life to dwell within us.

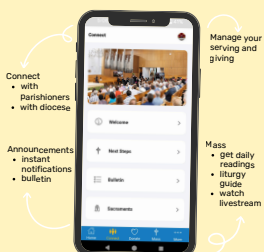

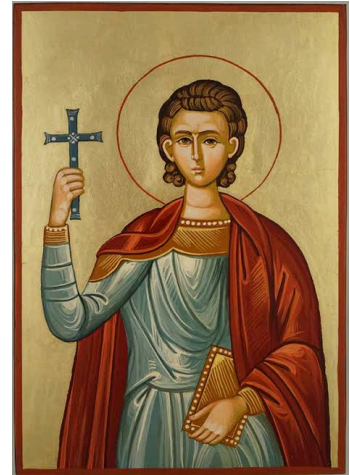

12 May - St Pancras (died c.304), Martyr

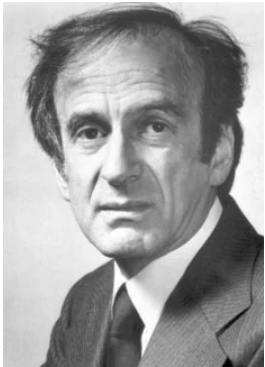
This Roman martyr is buried on the Aurelian Way just outside Rome. Some legends say that he was born in the East, orphaned, brought to Rome by an uncle, and martyred at the age of fourteen, but there is no particular reason to believe them.

The cult of St Pancras spread widely in the sixth century: in England, the first church that St Augustine built in Canterbury was dedicated to him.

...that the Holy Spirit is given many different titles in the scriptures?

This weekend we hear Jesus refer to the Holy Spirit as “the Spirit of truth.” (John 14:17). The Holy Spirit is also referred to by Jesus as the “Paraclete”, which means Advocate. St Paul also gives the Holy Spirit many titles, including the Spirit of the promise, the Spirit of adoption, the Spirit of Christ, the Spirit of the Lord, and the Spirit of God. St Peter refers to the Holy Spirit as the Spirit of glory. See the Catechism for more information, sections 691-701.
