By the Spirit put to death the misdeeds of the flesh

HUMAN BEINGS stand out as the glory of God's creation since they were created in the image and likeness of God (Gen. 1:26ff). It follows that they were created to reflect and radiate the glory of God to the rest of creation. However, disaster struck when through the antics of the devil human beings lost their pristine status by disobeying God (Gen. 3). Through this fall, they became unable to achieve any goodness on their own. This is what St Augustine describes as concupiscence. Therefore, left to human beings alone, they are unable to achieve perfection unaided by God's grace. However, all thanks to God through the gift of His Son Jesus Christ, the original innocence lost through the disobedience of Adam and Eve was restored. This is the enablement needed to do good and avoid evil. Hence Christians are challenged and encouraged to avail themselves of this benevolence by avoiding sins and all sinful inclinations. It is a call to repentance in order to embrace the new way of life in Christ.



The prophet Zechariah says in the First Reading that our God comes humbly to us (Zech. 9:9). The Christian is being called to a life of humility and not of arrogance and pride. It is in the nature of human beings to be proud and self-centred. It is only through this conversion of heart that one can become humble, unassuming and selfless. This point is being made succinctly by St Paul in the Second Reading today when he says that if we continue to live according to our unspiritual nature, we are doomed to die but "if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live." (Rom. 8:13) Humility is a virtue that is bestowed by God which we must always pray to have. St Paul makes this point in his letter to the Philippians, that we must be like Christ in humility and self-sacrifice (Phil. 2:6-11).

In the gospel passage of today (Matt. 11:25-30), Jesus invites us to take him as our teacher and mentor. He says: "Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls" (Matt. 11:29). We are thus encouraged to have a childlike attitude to life. We must be 'children' when it comes to vices and sins (1 Cor. 14:20). This is not something that comes easy. Hence Jesus says: "Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest." (Matt. 11:28) Let us learn at the feet of Jesus how to be humble, selfless, holy, chaste and self-effacing. In the midst of the world that is ruled by the principle of 'might is right' where the superpowers of the world are using their influence to oppress the weaker nations, we must come close to God "who has hidden these things from the wise and the learned and revealed them to little children." (Matt. 11:25) Let us be ruled and guided by the Spirit of God rather than by our human inclinations. This is something we cannot achieve solely by our own efforts (Rom. 7:14-24).

Pilgrimage to Turkey in 2027 - Fr Robert

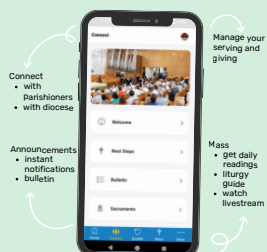
I am looking to see if there is any interest amongst parishioners for a pilgrimage to Turkey in **October next year (2027)**. This pilgrimage, titled "In the Footsteps of St Paul", is a comprehensive tour of key sites associated with St Paul and the early Church. I led a similar tour back in 2014 which was very positively received by those who travelled with me. Among other places, we will visit Cappadocia, some of the sites of church communities mentioned in the Book of Revelation, Kusadasi, Ephesus (including Mary's House), and Gallipoli, a special place for Australians. Of course, many other places are on the agenda. At this stage, the tour is planned for **08 - 21 October**, with an optional extension to Greece also possible. The Turkey pilgrimage is expected to cost around \$7800 per person, including flights, hotels, meals and tours with a guide, etc.

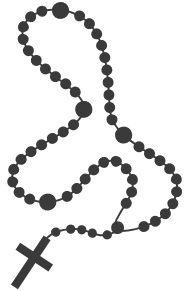
Rosary Workshops in July 2026

Saints of the Week

09 July - St Augustine Zhao Rong and his Companions, Martyrs

Augustine Zhao Rong was one of the Chinese soldiers who escorted Bishop John Gabriel Taurin Dufresse to his execution. Moved by his patience, he asked to be baptised, and in due course was sent to the seminary and ordained a priest. He was arrested and savagely tortured. He died in 1815.

With him are celebrated 119 of his companions in martyrdom in China between 1648 and 1930 (including Bishop Dufresse).

Official persecution of Christians by the Emperors ceased in 1842, but violent anti-religious sentiments persisted, and in the Boxer Rebellion of 1900, Christians were particularly attacked and many thousands were killed.

However, because of the importance of this sacrament, the Church has made provision for this sacrament to be administered in an emergency by “any person who has the requisite intention to do so.” (Canon 861)
