Listening for God's Gentle Voice

IN OUR READINGS TODAY, we hear of two great theophanies—manifestations of God—drawn out of times of chaos. The prophet Elijah, in our first reading, is fleeing for his life from the wicked and powerful Queen Jezebel after spectacularly defeating her prophets of the pagan Baal, bringing an end to the devastating drought plaguing the Promised Land. In our Gospel, after the wonder of the feeding of the five thousand, the apostles find themselves in a terrifying situation as the waves and the wind threaten to capsize their boat on the Sea of Galilee, as they attempt to withdraw from the region of Herod, who had just martyred St John the Baptist.



Just as our Lord attempts a retreat from the rowdiness of His ministry, retreating atop a mountain, Elijah, in his distress, surrenders himself in a dark cave atop Mt Horeb/Sinai, the place of the covenant. Just when it seems nothing could be worse for the prophet, a terrifying fire, wind and earthquake strike. Yet, even amid this, Elijah hears God in the silent "gentle breeze".

How often do we find ourselves beset by the chaos of our lives, struggling to keep our boats afloat, tempted to hide away in the cave? The apostles, relying on their own power, descend into panic; Elijah reaches despair, and yet the voice of God still calls them out: out of the cave, out of the boat. When we face the lofty call of the Christian life in a fallen world so hostile to the truth of the faith, it might seem simpler to "throw in the towel", to be "realistic", and accept that we stand no chance against the looming waves.

In each of us, however, is that quiet voice of conscience. Although at times we experience this voice as a tormentor, it is really more indicative of the torment we find ourselves in, and it offers us a helping hand. It is the encouraging voice that calls us to continue our journey out of the cave and venture into the treacherous storm with the courage to face terror head-on. St John Henry Cardinal Newman calls this voice "the Aboriginal Vicar of Christ", like the built-in spark of the divine.

We are challenged today to enter the quiet respite of prayer, especially when it seems like the least rational course of action. Although we might be tempted to surrender to the darkness of the cave or jump overboard, we must hold course in the ship of the Church, which, though rocky at times, will lead us to the shores of eternal life.

As we approach the feast of the Assumption at the end of this week, we look up to the Stella Maris (Star of the Sea), who illuminates this way through the darkness, shining the comfort of hope as she helps us navigate to our heavenly destination.

Homeless Shelter Trial Update

Dear Parishioners,

There has been a lot of activity post-Easter to plan the overnight shelter trial. We have met with Council planning staff and understand we need to lodge a development application. Work is in progress to gather the documents needed to support the DA. Parramatta Police have been briefed on the trial and are supportive. Uniting NSW, who employ two social workers based at Parramatta Mission, are progressing an agreement with the parish to do the assessments and referrals for the trial. There has been engagement with the Chancery regarding insurance and risk assessment. Mattresses, linen and blankets have been donated. Volunteers have been identified from the cathedral parish, other parishes and other faith communities. The trial will be considered as a parish ministry. Volunteer onboarding will start in August. We hope to meet with Orange Sky during August to explore their support for the trial with mobile showers and laundry washing. Bishop Vincent has also been given an update briefing on the trial during July. The current overnight shelters interstate are running their winter programs. We are in contact with them to learn from their operational experiences and apply this knowledge to the upcoming trial.

Please continue to keep the shelter trial, all those involved in planning and delivering the trial, plus our friends experiencing homelessness, in your prayers.

Seniors' Ministry Event

On Wednesday, 05 August, our Seniors Ministry was delighted to welcome Sister Mary and Sister Kerry from the Mary MacKillop Shrine in North Sydney, who shared a fascinating presentation on Australia's first saint, St Mary of the Cross MacKillop. It was especially lovely to welcome Pat back - it was so good to see her with us again!



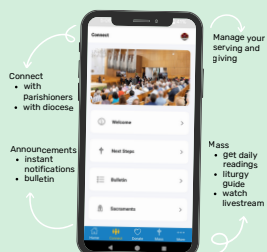

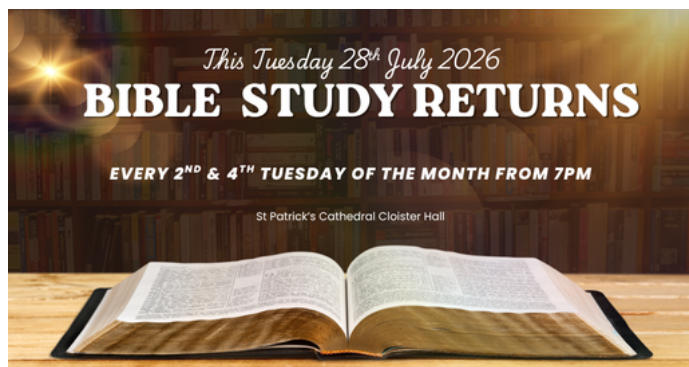

Volunteer with the Order of Malta Community Care Van

The Order of Malta Community Care Van provides practical support and companionship to people experiencing homelessness in Parramatta.

Each week, volunteers distribute essential items including waterproof coats for the homeless during winter, sun protection items in summer, water, food, clothing, hygiene packs, and basic first aid assistance when trained volunteers are available. Just as importantly, volunteers spend time listening to and engaging with those they meet, offering friendship and human connection.

The Community Care Van operates from St Patrick's Cathedral, Parramatta. Volunteers gather at the van in the Cathedral parking lot before walking through Alfred Park, along Church Street, and to Parramatta Station, distributing items and connecting with people in need along the way.

Saints of the Week

13 August - St Pontian (Pope) & St Hippolytus (Priest) (d.235)

Hippolytus was a priest and a learned man, the most important writer of the Church at Rome in the early third century. He strongly attacked the popes of the time, and was set up as a rival Pope to St Callistus. Some time later, in Maximin's persecution, he was sent to labour in the quarries of Sardinia. There he met the then Pope, Pontian, and was reconciled with him.

Pontian was made Pope in 231, and was sent to the quarries in 235, where he resigned the papacy and died.

Pontian's successor, Fabian, had both bodies brought back to Rome for burial, and Pontian and Hippolytus were already being venerated by the Roman Church by the start of the fourth century.
