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Don't drop the ball!

ON 8TH AUGUST there was a match in the NRL round 23, with the Broncos versus the Dolphins. At half time the Broncos were winning 24 – Nil, but by full time the Dolphins came back to win 40 – 32. In every sport we have seen this kind of thing happen – one team is well ahead, but they end up losing the game. Almost invariably it is not because the other team suddenly became better, it is because the team that was winning lost focus. In simple terms, it was there for them to win, but they dropped the ball.



This is a bit like what happened the Jews – they had been chosen out of all the nations on Earth to be God's special people. They were the "Chosen People", with a remarkable personal relationship with God who offered them a covenant, a special covenant just between Him and them. This put them in a unique position in the world. They were blessed. But what did they do? They dropped the ball. They lost focus. They worshipped other "gods", the gods of the people around them. Each time they lost focus, their nation paid a terrible price – they were conquered by other nations, and led into exile and slavery. God would call them back into relationship with Him and in time they would come back, but the cycle just repeated itself over and over – they would lose focus, drop the ball, and end up devastated all over again. In the end, God sent His son to them, the fulfillment of all their prophecies, but they rejected Him. In today's Gospel Jesus tells the Canaanite woman that he was called "only to the lost sheep of Israel." What happened next was so very important to us: The woman responded with such faith, that Jesus then engaged with her and gave her what she had asked of Him. This then set the scene for where things went ultimately – Jesus offered Himself first to the Jews but once they rejected Him, he offered Himself to every person who responded to Him with faith. Their loss was our gain, but what a loss that was.

We need to reflect on their experience. We are the new "Chosen People". We are the ones now being offered a deep and fruitful personal relationship with God. We are the ones being offered eternal salvation. The match is ours to win, but we must stay very aware of the danger that surrounds us. The mistake of the Jews was to lose focus on God and to turn their focus onto the "gods" and practices of the cultures around them. We face the very same danger. We are surrounded by a culture that focuses on (worships?) other gods – money, consumerism, career, power, sex, comfort, celebrity, appearance, individualism, social media, gods that shift their shape depending on our age and circumstances, but always demand the same thing: that God be moved aside. We must avoid the danger of being drawn into the culture of the people that surround us. We have been offered the greatest gifts that anyone could ask for – a fruitful personal relationship with God in this life, and an eternal life with Him in the next. It is ours for the taking. Let's make sure we don't drop the ball...

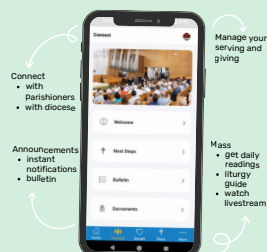

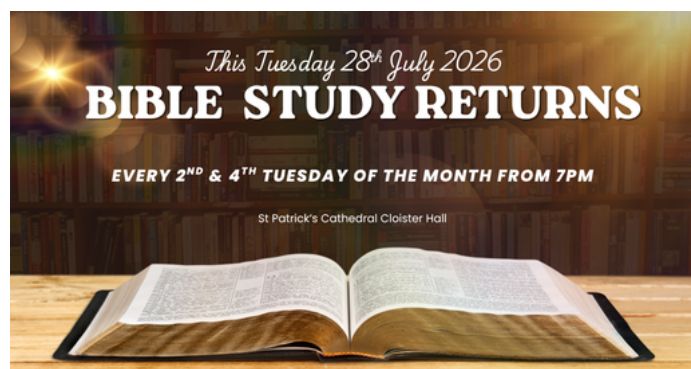
1. Scan QR Code to go to Google Play Store or Apple App Store on your mobile device.

Volunteer with the Order of Malta Community Care Van

The Order of Malta Community Care Van provides practical support and companionship to people experiencing homelessness in Parramatta.

Each week, volunteers distribute essential items including waterproof coats for the homeless during winter, sun protection items in summer, water, food, clothing, hygiene packs, and basic first aid assistance when trained volunteers are available. Just as importantly, volunteers spend time listening to and engaging with those they meet, offering friendship and human connection.

The Community Care Van operates from St Patrick's Cathedral, Parramatta. Volunteers gather at the van in the Cathedral parking lot before walking through Alfred Park, along Church Street, and to Parramatta Station, distributing items and connecting with people in need along the way.

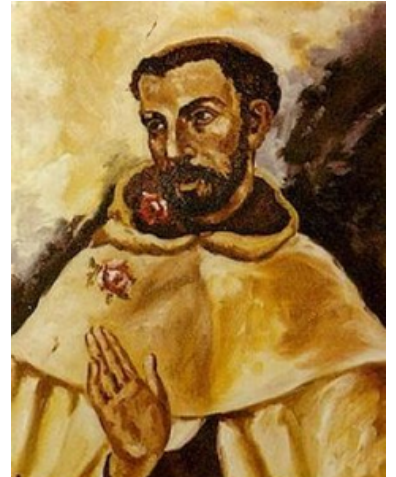

Saints of the Week

17 August - **Blessed Angelus Mazzinghi** (Priest) (1386 - 1438)

Angelus was born near Florence, around the year 1386. He entered the Carmelite Order in 1413, being later ordained a priest in 1415. He was the first member of the reform movement delle selve (of the woods), which began in the convent of Santa Maria delle Selve at Lastra a Signa, west of Florence, a reform that later spread to the Carmelite Congregation of Mantua. Angelus served as prior of the reformed community from 1419 to 1430, as well as prior for two years in the community of Florence. He was a lector (teacher) in theology and was renowned for his preaching, no doubt arising from a deep love and practice of praying the Scriptures in his Carmelite life. Angelus is often depicted in iconography with flowers falling from his mouth as he preaches. He died in Florence on the 17th August 1438.

Did You Know...?

...that when the priest rinses his hands before beginning the Eucharistic Prayer, it is for a symbolic reason?

The washing of the hands parallels the washing rituals used by many people of other faiths such as Islam and Judaism. The priest says quietly: "Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin." Both the basin used for this purpose and the ritual itself are referred to as the *lavabo*. This Latin word, meaning "I shall wash" is the first word of Psalm 26, the psalm recited by priests in earlier times during this ritual.
