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THE ABSURDITY OF THE PAPACY

ONE of the more perplexing and disagreeable doctrines in our Church is that of the Papacy. I think as Catholics, we are so accustomed to the Petrine office that we fail to appreciate how this apostolic foundation stone can become a stumbling stone for so many. In our readings today, we revisit the pivotal scene in which St Peter is granted the keys to the kingdom and the authority to bind and loose. In many ways, this scene should confound the reader: how could Christ entrust such an office to someone as flawed as St Peter? In next week's Gospel, we will see St Peter try to deny the reality of the Cross, as he will the washing of the feet on Holy Thursday. Last week, we saw him lose faith as he began to drown in the stormy waters; likewise, he will abandon Christ on Good Friday.



In our First Reading today, we see the prophet Isaiah prophesy against Shebna, the asher al-habayth- "master of the palace." This "office," established by King Solomon (1 Kings 4:6), established its holder as the 2IC, a kind of prime minister. Isaiah conveys a successive office in which its holder is vested with the authoritative keys to "open and close," or, as Christ puts it, to "bind and loose." This man is to act as a father (e.g., Papa > Pope), sharing in the fatherhood of the King for the then-covenant people of God. Shebna is also a flawed man, abusing his office for self-aggrandizement, resulting in his divine dismissal and God's succession plan in Eliakim.

Unlike Shebna, St Peter will grow into his office, no longer attempting to evade the Cross, pouring out his life in his apostolic ministry. Undergoing imprisonments, humiliations, persecutions, and poverty, he will lay down his life with his brother Paul; he will embrace and witness to the Cross, according to tradition, being crucified upside-down.

The scandal of the Papacy, bearing the impossible burden of the Keys of Salvation, is no more outrageous than the scandal of the Incarnation, of God becoming man—Creator becoming creature. It is no more shocking than God being crucified or a man resurrecting from the dead. We have seen disappointing and unseemly papacies throughout the history of the Church, and yet vice and sin, deficiencies and shortcomings have never been an obstacle to our Almighty God. For, despite any faults in particular hierarchs, God has always preserved the authentic faith of the One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church.

The fallible nature of humanity, even sadly exposed in particular Popes, should not be a deterrent to this divinely instituted office, but rather evidence of the Holy Spirit working through it. For is it any less absurd that God would also elect us to be His chosen people, entrust us with the precious gift of salvation, and assign us the daunting task of preaching the Gospel?

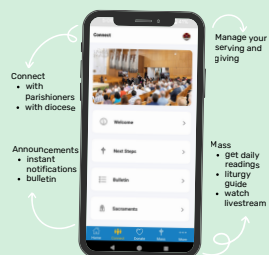

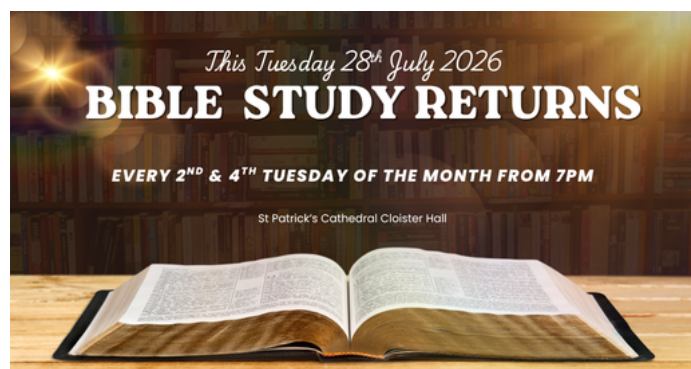
1. Scan QR Code to go to Google Play Store or Apple App Store on your mobile device.

Saint of the Week

25 August - St Louis (1214 - 1270)

He became King of France (as Louis IX) at the age of 12. He was married and had eleven children, to whom he gave an excellent upbringing. He was noted for his spirit of prayer and penitence and for his love for the poor. He ran his kingdom not only to give peace to the people and economic stability but also for their spiritual good. He founded the Sorbonne and was a friend of St Thomas Aquinas. He was a member of the Order of Penitents of St Francis of Assisi, which later became the Franciscan Third Order and is now known as the Secular Franciscan Order (OFS).

Louis was trusted by his fellow-rulers in Europe and often asked to arbitrate in their disputes. He undertook two unsuccessful crusades to liberate Christ's burial-place and on the second of these he died, near Carthage, in the year 1270.
